#### Postgraduate Training Recognized by BCPS

A high powered inspection team consisting of nine members from the Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons (BCPS) Dhaka, headed by Professor Md. Monimul Haque, visited Jalalabad Ragib-Rabeya Medical College and Hospital on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2014.
